- 10 years later 2015
 - Eastbound lanes = Concrete (initial quote \$600,000 higher than asphalt)
 - No rehabilitation
 - Westbound lanes = Asphalt
 - Repairs began in 2010 (and continued until...)
 - Total resurfacing in 2014 at a cost to taxpayers of \$1,800,000
 - Current day costs have concrete equal to asphalt
